THE PARAPHRASE IT METHOD OF BIBLE MEDITATION

- Read the verse or passage over and over.
- Think about what God is saying to you from the verse or passage.
- Put the verse or passage in your own words.
- Search your heart to see how the verse or passage applies to you.
- Talk to God about it in prayer.

The goal is to be able to explain the entire verse or passage in your own words. It is never enough to just know what the Bible says; you also need to know what the Bible means. If you cannot put it in your own words then you don't truly understand what it is saying.

Example:

I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

Psalm 119:11 NIV

Pastor Mike's Paraphrase: "I have embraced and committed to memory your Word, so that when tempted I will not yield to sin."

As you read God's Word, say back to God what you heard Him say to you, using your own words. Then respond to Him with your thoughts and prayers and begin to live it out in your life.
